It has come to my attention that there is confusion about some things that were read in previous newsletters. Allow me to explain...

We are NOT forcing Pr. Eric to leave Circle of Faith Parish!

We are, however, working on ensuring adequate, stable pastoral coverage for Circle of Faith for the future. Pr. Eric has expressed an interest in retiring within the next couple

of years. No date or official retirement announcement has been made. Given this news, however, the Parish Council and I are exploring our staffing options to fill Pr. Eric's position whenever he does retire. Thanks to Pr. Eric we have the unique opportunity to make plans for a smooth transition whenever he decides to spend more time golfing and fishing rather than preaching and teaching.

The Parish Council and I want to be transparent with you. We want you to know that we are exploring options. Now given the current landscape within the greater church, we realize that it might be challenging to find an ordained pastor who is willing to work part-time. And even though we certainly are open to calling a part-time ordained pastor, we are also exploring the option of a seminary intern. This intern would be a student who is training to be an ordained pastor. Part of their educational training involves hands on ministry in a congregational setting. More information about what it means for Circle of Faith to be an internship site will be given later if this option is determined to be the direction that God is leading us towards.

Other options that we are exploring include a parish nurse or a youth director. The parish nurse would be a paid staff person who would help with visitation and bringing Holy Communion to our homebound members. The youth director would be a paid staff person who would help with confirmation and various youth activities within the parish.

Finally, the Parish Council, Pr. Eric and I are also working on answering the question, "What does Circle of Faith look like as three congregations being served by one pastor?" To answer this question, we welcome your input and suggestions. There is no right or wrong answer to this question. In the nearly 10 years of our three congregations working on partnered ministry (7 years officially together as Circle of Faith), we know that our ministry is a partnership and any good partnership takes compromises. As we continue to work together as three congregations doing partnered ministry together, we walk by faith, trusting in God's will for St. Peter, Trinity, Waverly AND Circle of Faith Parish.

I pray that you all had a wonderful Thanksgiving celebration with family and friends. May you all have a blessed Advent!

Meeting was called to order by Steve.

Agenda was submitted and motion to approve. Motion carried.

Secretary's Report was read, motion to approve, and carried.

Treasurer's Report was read. Budget was reviewed. Brandon stated that Crystal Valley would be sending a check for corn sold in for Waverly. There would also be an amount coming from Cargill. Motion made to approve the report, motion carried.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Anthony thanked the council and expressed gratitude to the Congregation for his vacation time and for having flexibility in the past year. Also wanted to thank Don and Nancy for taking the kids. Change to Confirmation this year. There will 2 meetings per month for 2 hours versus a weekly class. The plan is to allow for more hands on activities in addition to the lecture. (Such as making Communion Bread.) So far it is going well. In August the Synod met in Milwaukee. The Bishop was reelected and will serve for another 6 years.

Constitution updates will be shared at the annual meeting of Waverly Church.

Committee Reports:

Worship: Will meet in October.

Caring Ministries: Continue community visits. They will be adding several new members to visit in the near future. The people have expressed appreciation of the large print materials.

Faith Formation: Going well. Luann Peterson will now be assisting with the younger kids. Work will begin on the Christmas Program in November.

Property: The lights went out in the Church last week. A dimmer fuse blew. It is unclear if it is currently working. There is a wet spot near the piano. Has been an issue in the past. Is likely due to a valve. Watson's will be out to evaluate the boiler for the year. The heat is currently working. Brian has been fixing the screens and will continue in the spring.

Endowment: Will have a meeting in the fall.

Parish Council Report: the Council has been busy related to the Pastoral transition planning. Pastor Eric will at some point make the decision to retire. There have been discussions of hosting internships where the Church would have the opportunity to become educator in the process. It will be difficult to find a part-time Pastor. Other outside the box ideas are being welcomed. The future will need to be met with open minds and willingness

Old Business: The app Tithe.ly was brought forth by Pastor Anthony. It is an app designed to streamline giving and would allow those who want to give remotely or not at a service the opportunity. It can be set up for routine donations or single donations. It allows for year-end tax documentation. Anyone can use the app and donate. It does not have to be a member. Trinity is moving ahead with the app. The app will be presented at the Annual Meeting. A suggestion was made by Don to mention the app each week at the service to the Congregation. Some of the Council Members will begin using the app in order to share their experience at the Annual Meeting.

New Business: Corn has been donated in Waverly's name. December will be open for nominations of the new council members for opening positions. Will need to nominate a Nominating Committee. The president is the previous Council President and 4 others will need to be determined. Suggested members included Mary Lou Sherman, Gwen Matz, Jon Helvig, Sue Rathman, and Belva Peterson. Steve will connect with Jon to get the process started. The CD is due in November. A motion was made to renew and then discuss how to handle it in the new year. Motion carried.

The December Council meeting will be a party. At the meeting the agenda for the annual meeting will be prepared.

Annual Meeting is scheduled for January 19, 2020. Motion made to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned.

What is Holy Communion? We believe that Holy Communion is the

body and blood of Jesus given with bread and wine, instituted by Christ himself for us to eat and drink. We believe that in this Holy Meal, we physically and spiritually receive Christ and the forgiveness of our sins.

The landscape is changing; we all know that. People come to worship when they can. Often this means that their schedules might not line up with our church's Holy Communion schedule. If we believe that Holy Communion is the nourishment and forgiveness of sins that we need, then why not offer this meal and celebrate this sacrament every Sunday? It is out of good hospitality that we celebrate Holy Communion every time that we gather, rather than a couple times per month. So that no matter when someone walks through our doors to join us for worship, there the sacrament of Holy Communion will be there for their nourishment and forgiveness of sins. Whenever someone is in need of Jesus and this Holy Meal, they can easily find it.

At Trinity's last council meeting, we decided to try celebrating weekly Communion throughout the season of Advent. For the entire month of December, the Sacrament of Holy Communion will be offered. When you come to our Lord's table to receive the Sacrament of His own body and blood, trust that all of your sins are indeed forgiven and that Jesus goes with you as you go back into the world as a forgiven child of God!


