Welcoming First Lutheran to Circle of Faith Parish

The Parish Council is excited to announce that we have entered into an interim parish agreement with First Lutheran Church of Trimont. Over the last few months, the Parish Council has been meeting with representatives of First Lutheran to determine if a partnership is in the best interest of all four congregations. It was agreed to continue these conversations in further exploring a full partnership.

What Does Interim Parish Agreement Mean?

The councils agreed to a six-month Interim Parish Agreement which began on January 1, 2021 and runs through June 30, 2021. During this interim time, Circle of Faith and First Lutheran will be exploring what a full partnership would look like. This includes conversations about:

Ministry goals for the parish and each congregation Pastoral and support staffing needs within the parish Worship and programming schedules Budget proposals

What's Next?

After these topics are discussed, a final proposal will be presented to each church council. Upon approval, a congregational meeting and vote will be held. A full partnership with all four congregations would require approval from each congregation. Because of the COVID restrictions, the parish council was concerned about reaching a quorum for the congregational votes. To allow time to explore this possible partnership, it was decided to begin an interim period where we partner together in some ways.

While many aspects of our ministry will remain unchanged during this interim period, there are a few areas that will look different.

Pastor Anthony and Pastor Stephanie will be providing shared pastoral duties among all four congregations.

Waverly and First Lutheran will be switching worship times on a monthly basis.

Marilyn Cheever called the meeting to order. Jody Franck made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Nancy Nordstrom. Approved.

Pastor Stephanie shared a devotion based on 1 Corinthians 12:12-27 about working together and patience paying off.

Nancy Nordstrom made a motion to accept the secretary's report as printed, seconded by John Borchardt. Approved.

MaryAnn Frerichs made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as printed, seconded by Jody Franck. Approved.

Pastor's reports

Pastor Stephanie will be teaching a class on suicide prevention Monday and Tuesday in New Ulm. They are working on Lent.

Pastor Anthony is registered for the Safe Talk training in April. They will schedule a training locally probably in May. He will be receiving training on group cast, the new messaging system on Wednesday. It can do more than Honeywell.

Congregation reports

Waverly and Trinity have had meeting regarding budgets. St. Peter is meeting to discuss theirs the day of their drive through communion.

Marilyn commented on how moving the Christmas Eve service was.

New Business

In person activities – with numbers being stable along with following mask and distancing rules it was felt that in person would be safe. Jody Franck made a motion to resume in person worship January 17,2021, but continue the drive through communion for those not comfortable coming in the buildings, seconded by Nancy Nordstrom. Approved.

Interim worship schedule will be for St. Peter to remain at 8:30 and Trinity at 10:30. First and Waverly with alternate monthly, in January First will be at 9:00

and Waverly 10:30, February Waverly will be 9:00 and First 10:30.

Lenten Services – Circle of Faith has normally rotated. After some discussion Marilyn Cheever made a motion to have all the Lenten services from Ash Wednesday through Good Friday at Trinity as a central location and loose offering will be split between the Trimont food shelf and Heaven's Table, services will start at 6:30, seconded by Nancy Nordstrom. Approved.

Interim Discussion Plan – this was started by looking at the parish mission statement. What stands out to us in it, many parts were highlighted. It was brought up that growing has always been a dream. Talked about what they felt we were doing good, working together, welcoming neighbors (First). Things we could do better, support of food shelf, work at serving others, need to let go of some resources, sometimes lean towards grumbling over sharing hope. It was brought up that we might be able to serve at the Banquet in Sioux Falls after covid. Talked about how we are better at discipleship as a group than as individuals. We need to involve more people. Starts with each person-stop negative comments.


