"Neither is new wine put into old wineskins; otherwise, the skins burst, and the wine is spilled, and the skins are destroyed; but new wine is put into fresh wineskins, and so both are preserved." -Matthew 9:17

Dear Friends at Circle of Faith,

I have to admit, since I don't drink, I can't say if this verse is literally accurate from personal experience. But there are times in the life of the church when we need to "examine our wineskins," to discover which are still fresh and which need changing out. Over the last few weeks, it has sounded to me like the people at all the congregations of Circle of Faith have plenty of practice at this already! The old wineskin of, "this is Minnesota, why would we need air conditioning?," was set aside, and AC was installed. The old wineskin of, "how could we be church without having potlucks?," was set aside for a time, and pandemic safety guidelines were followed. Meanwhile the wineskins of traditional liturgy, beloved hymns, and for that matter having a church newsletter, have remained fresh and continue to serve the parish well!

We are delighted to officially welcome First Lutheran of Trimont into the Circle of Faith family! And we also recognize that this is a change for First, and there may also be changes in store for St. Peter, Trinity, and Waverly as well. But we don't need to look at these changes with worry, or be overly hesitant. The truth I is that all of our congregations have been changing since the moment they were founded. Even as certain parts of the sanctuary stayed the same, the members of the congregation changed. Even as some parts of the worship service stayed the same, how the congregation made decisions changed. Our congregations have faced changes including the language of worship services, the welcoming of women as pastors, and even the growing presence of technology in how we function as a community. With each of these choices, we left some old wineskins behind, but the fresh wineskins we chose have served well to share the Gospel in our communities.

As we go forward, we have many choices to make. And as always, our first concern will not be, "what will serve us best?," because being church is not about serving ourselves. Instead we will continue to ask, "what will serve God best?" What choices will build the kingdom of God here in the Ceylon/Welcome/ Trimont area? What choices will lead to our communities being more centered on the Gospel and less centered on greed, selfishness, or prejudice? What choices will best welcome those who are vulnerable, or powerless, or least able to help themselves? Because these are who Jesus centered his life and ministry around.

One of Martin Luther's more famous comments was when he said, "I have so much to do today, I shall have to spend the first 3 hours in prayer!" Since we have all these decisions in front of us, let's begin in prayer with and for one another. Sign up at your congregation for the Circle of Faith Prayer Partners program, to be paired with a member at another of our congregations to pray for, for 8 weeks, as we enter into this new time of ministry together. 
