Discussion on the future of Circle of Faith, the council discussed several different ideas.


Discussion on federal holidays for the Pastors and office admin.

Approved Agenda

Devotions – Passed on as Pastor was not there yet. Secretary's Report – None

Treasurer's Report – Becky D. went through report. Lonnie M made motion to accept Treasurer's report as given, Jeff Miller seconded. Passed

Pastor's Report – She reported that the 1st Communion Class went well. Reported that Marilyn and Lon Oelke will be going back to Marilyn's childhood church.

Committee Reports:

*Faith Formation – WOW had 3 attendees. There are 13 in 6^{th} grade and under that could attend.

*Caring Ministries – Hoping to get lay people to go to the shut-ins as we did previously. There are about 18 or 19 every month (all 4 churches). These lay people would give communion as before. There are also about 2 or 3 winter ones that do not go out in the winter. Pastor Kelly has also been ministering to the Janssen family after the loss of their son.

*Property – Bob M. said the two trees in front of the church have ash bore disease and should be taken down before they are totally dead. Bob will take them down with help. A work day is scheduled for April 23, 2022 to help take the trees down.

After the trees come down there is work that needs to be done on the gutters and gutter helmets. Jay M will contact Schmidt Siding on the gutters and will contact the gutter helmet people to have them come and fix some of the helmets.

- -The pastor and secretary's offices don't have much heat. Bob has contacted A-OK to fix it.
- -The bats have been taken care of as of last November.
- -The front of the church needs to be stained again. Bob M will bring his pressure washer in and wash it down on April 23. It will need to dry for about a week before the staining can be done.
- -The lawn mowing at the church was discussed. It was decided that the council members will take care of the mowing and trimming this summer.

Jon will take care of notifying Phil.

*Renovation - Carpeting was discussed. The carpet at the front of the church should be replaced or at the least it needs to be stretched.

Old Business:

*Heaven's Table needs help with the distribution of the goods once a month on the 4th Friday of the month. So far have had people take care of it.

New Business:

*The elevator has been fixed and is ready for use again.

Council Approval:

At the annual meeting the jobs of President and financial secretary were not filled. Jon S will be President again and Lonnie M. will be financial secretary. Becky D made a motion to approve Jon and Lonnie in these positions. Jay M. seconded it. Motion carried.


