

## Prayer for the Day



Bible Study: The August study in the Gather.

Take time to read the story on quilting from the May/June 2022 Gather pages 29-31. A late report from our quilting days. We had 6 days to work with 6-8 workers each day. 30 will go to LWR, 20 to E'ville Xmas, 5 Okoboji auction, 7 to Mankato Salvation Army, 4 to confirmands, and 5 kept for local needs.

There were 36 left from last year for LWR, so on May 14, my son and I delivered 66 to LWR and 10 school kits and \$100 for shipping. These are left at 1st Lutheran church. A semi is there with a conveyor belt. In less than 10 minutes, everything is unloaded and ready to go to St. Paul warehouse and later to be sent to Mission destinations. Mission in Action.

Two organizations helping after hurricanes are the Red Cross and Samaritans Purse. Even though we aren't able to volunteer, the gift on money is very important, Franklin Graham says, people have lost everything and they help them put their lives together again.

The WELCA Triennial Convention took place July 11-16. Phoebe Hospital news updates: Liberian students have been selected for intensive solar training. A formal ribbon cutting at Phoebe will be Nov. 16. Solar oven demonstrations will be given and the upcoming Curran Hospital project will be discussed. Curran is a 112 bed hospital struggling financially. Solar power will help them greatly.

The Ingham Lake Ice Cream Social was well attended at the beautiful new dining hall overlooking the lake. The Hog Roast will be August 28th.

The Okoboji quit auction will be Aug. 6 with viewing Aug. 5th. We have donated 5 quilts for this.

Congratulation to our confirmands, Tyler Poppe, Michael McCorkell, DJ Miller and Riley Ebeling.

Our latest treasury amount is \$523.43 with donations to Relay for Life for \$50 and \$100 to Lutheran Word Relief.
