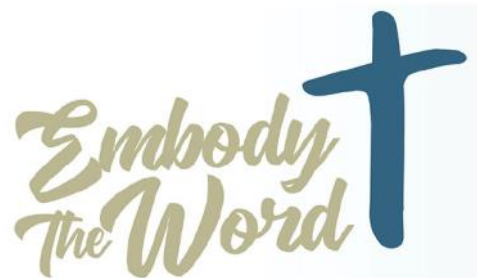

Called to order by President Jeff Lueth on August 10. Members present were: Jeff, Deanne, Tim, MaryLou and Pastor Kelly.

Secretary report was accepted as read with motion by Tim and 2nd by Deanne. Motion carried.

Treasurer report shows a balance on July 31 of \$84,000.81. Tithing continues to be an option for those streaming or unable to attend the service. Motion by Tim, 2nd by MaryLou to accept the financial report. Motion carried.

Old Business: Motion by Deanne and 2nd by Tim to have Matt Petroviak wash all church windows, clean light fixtures and fans for \$780.00. It was decided to hold off with cleaning carpets this year as not many activities have taken place in the church the past couple years. Lawn mowing continues to be done by members as needed.

Pastor Report: It was suggested by COF Parishes share a unified mission. After much discussion, it was decided to set Sunday, Sept. 11 as Food Security Sunday. Monetary collections on that day will be used to purchase boxes of fruit from the local schools FFA and donate it to our area food shelf.

We were informed that Pastor Kay's last Sunday will be Sept. 11 as she has accepted a call to Immanuel Lutheran in New Auburn, MN. At that time Waverly and First will be partnering with church services at 10:30. St. Peter and Trinity will partner with a service at 9:00. Starting in September, all churches will share Sunday school.

Confirmation for 7th & 8th graders will be at Trinity every other Wednesday starting at 4:30. One adult will need to be present at each confirmation class.

The Call Committee continues to search for a new pastor and will try to expand their efforts and not set as many limits for a new pastor.

New Business: Motion by Tim and 2nd by Deanne to reimburse \$150 to each Kiley and Kelly Bettin for expenses incurred while attending the National Youth Gathering in Houston, TX. Motion carried.
