
Lent Begins with Ash Wednesday.

Trinity Lutheran Church — Annual Meeting January 15, 2023

Meeting was called to order by Jon Saxen, President, at 9:50 a.m. Pastor Kelly led the congregation in the Liturgy.

Bob Moffitt made a motion to approve the agenda with organist being added under New Business. Becky Detert seconded. Carried.

Secretary's Report – Bob Moffitt made a motion to approve the Minutes from the January 23, 2022 annual meeting. Jean Schock seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – The 2022 year end review was gone over and also the 2023 budgets for Trinity and Circle of Faith Parish. Jeff Miller made a motion to approve both budgets, Bob Moffitt seconded. Motion carried. Becky Detert thanked the people that mowed the church lawn last summer and also Henry for the doing the cemetery.

Pastor's report was included in the annual report. Pastor Kelly thanked everyone for their help in making things go easier with only one Pastor.

Bob Moffitt made a motion to approve the ballot as presented in the report, Henry Borchardt seconded. Motion carried. Those elected were:

Old Business

- Parish Update We will be cutting back to one pastor for 2023.
- The call committee is doing an Amendment to the Parish profile.
- The schedule for the Lenten services will be in the newsletter coming out.
- The date of the Church anniversary was asked about. The year for this is 2024.

New Business

• Jon Saxen has been checking on keyboards so that we would have music in the event that we don't have an organist for some of the services. He has been working with a company in Mankato dealing with a keyboard, audio and software to make everything compatible with our present equipment. We would also need someone to record the service/hymns. Approximate cost would not exceed \$5,000. Becky Detert made a motion to use memorial money for the purchase of the equipment/software that would be necessary. Bob Moffitt seconded. Carried. Jean Schock said the women had some money that they would be willing to contribute to the cost if needed.

Lonnie Moffitt made a motion to adjourn, Bob Moffitt seconded. Carried

President Jeff Lueth called 2023 Annual Meeting to order on Sunday, January 15 at 6 pm. 22 members present.

Pastor Kelly opened with Liturgy and prayer.

Secretary Report: Minutes were read from the 2022 Annual meeting. Motion was made by Brad to accept and seconded by Nancy. Motion carried

Treasurer's Report: Deanne reviewed and presented the 2023 proposed Income/Expense and Budget report. End of year checking account has a balance of \$91,387.82. A CD with 1/2% interest shows a balance of \$29,066.04 Don moved/Bob seconded to approve the proposed budget or 2023 and a motion to accept the 2023 final budget was also passed.

Our parish had chosen last Sept. 11 as Food Insecurity Sunday. All monetary collections on that Sunday were used to purchase boxes of fruit from area schools FFA and then donated to local food shelves. A total offering of \$1,428 was collected allowing Waverly students from MCW and Truman schools to purchase boxes of fruit. The recipients of apples and oranges were Heaven's Table-Sherburn site, Trimont Food Shelf, Heaven's Table-Fairmont and Ruby's Pantry-Sherburn. A big thank you to Deanne for organizing and distributing the fruit.

Pastors Report: Pastor Kelly thanked everyone for stepping up and accepting their new roles.

COF Report: Nancy presented the COF Operating report. Checking account has a balance of \$32,341.46. Motion by Sue and seconded by Gwen to approve the budget. Question arose on the Operating Statement. Waverly Church assessment is 37% which is based on attendance. There was some discussion about base rate adjustment. With combining services, each church will keep track of their own attendance. The Parish Council has decided to add a parttime Parish Nurse. She will work with all congregations and help with meeting with shut-ins and visitations. The call committee is now looking at calling a single pastor leading worship at two of the four churches each Sunday.

Endowment Report: Sue reported grants totaling \$7,800 were presented to several college students this past year. There will be money to be disbursed again this year. Application to be given to Endowment Committee.

Nominating Committee Report: Bob Olson presented the slate of officers. Motion to accept a unanimous ballot was made and seconded.

Old Business: The shingles on the church are needing replacement. Prices vary and have gone up in price. Brad and Jeff will look into this and get some pricing quotes.

New Business: We were reminded that Waverly will be 125 years old in 2024. Nancy, Deanne, Belva and MaryLou volunteered to be on this committee. The printer at church is not working. It was suggested the council should decide on a replacement. The discussion continued on a security camera for the church. Custodial and choir pay will be unchanged. Harvest Homecoming with Gloria Dei was briefly discussed. Everyone was in agreement that we should go ahead with planning.

Motion made by Tim and seconded by Laurie to ament the constitution and change the quorum from 20 people to those present. Next year, Annual meeting will be after church services.

The 2024 Youth Convention will be held in New Orleans. 9th grade and up, even young adults, are encouraged to attend. Lenten suppers this year will be at Trinity and youth will be helping with these to help defray the cost.

No further business, Brad moved/Bob seconded to adjourn.
