# Be the donkey

Corrie ten Boom, a devout Christian who helped shelter hundreds of Jewish people from Nazis during World War II, was asked how she stayed humble despite her fame.



"When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday on the back of a donkey, and everyone was waving palm branches and throwing garments onto the road and singing praises, do you think that for one moment it ever entered the head of that donkey that any of that was for him?" she replied. "If I can be the donkey on which Jesus Christ rides in his glory, I give him all the praise and all the honor."

Jesus told his followers they'd need to carry (or "take up") their cross. But how well do you carry your Savior? How do you bring him into a world that desperately needs the good news of the gospel?

#### **WAVERLY ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES**

President Tim Peterson called the 2024 Annual Meeting to order on Sunday, February 4 following the worship service. 33 members present.

**PASTORS REPORT:** The opening liturgy is listed in the annual report. Pastor stated joint services are going well and thanked everyone for their flexibility. He stated he is always available for questions. 12 young people along with 2 chaperones will be attending the youth convention held in New Orleans this summer. The youth will be serving supper prior to Lenten services at Trinity at Welcome. A free will offering will be taken.

**SERETARY'S REPORT:** Minutes were read from the 2023 Annual meeting. A motion was made by Brad and seconded by Sue to accept. Motion carried.

**TREASURER'S REPORT**: The financial report was reviewed by Deanne. Several additions were added to the 2024 budget. It was reported the youth convention will cost app. \$2,000 per person. Motion by Laurie and seconded by Bob to add \$2,500 to the budget to help with costs. The \$1,500 set up for camp last year was never used.

-Waverly's 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary will be celebrated Sept. 8. Motion made by Jeff and seconded by Jammer to add \$7,500 to the budget for these expenses.

-Nancy brought to our attention that our SS children have ben attending VBS at 1<sup>st</sup> Covenant in Trimont during the summer where they receive materials and a meal while attending. Motion made by Nancy and seconded by Gwen to add \$500 to the education fund to help with these costs. Motion made by Don and seconded by Karen to accept the Treasurer's report.

**ENDOWMENT REPORT:** Jon briefly updated us on the Endowment Fund. Ending balance for 2023 was \$119,269.00. Motion by Bob and seconded by Nancy that funds for the Youth Convention and Anniversary Fund can also be applied for.

**COF REPORT:** Karen presented the COF Parish budget statement. The 4 churches are charged a flat fee with the rest covered with a percentage rate. Motion made by Nancy and seconded by Laurie to accept the 2024 operating budget. Motion passed.

-The copier needs replacement and has been approved for Susan to purchase another.

**NOMINATING COMMITTEE:** Bob thanked everyone for accepting their new role and then presented the slate of officers. Motion to accept a unanimous ballot was made and seconded.

No further business, motion by Bob and seconded by Susan to adjourn.


