

Pray for the remembrance of all who have gone before us. Whether it be loved ones, those who have defended our country, or those who are dear to us.



WORSHIP Schedule: 10:30 worship here at First

SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING SUNDAY, May 12th - following the service.

This will be to vote on the bids that the council has received for the shingling of the church

Roofing bids for First Lutheran and garage.

Council recommends asphalt shingles on the parsonage and garage. Bids range 19,500 up to 28,000—Labor included.

Roofing bids for Sanctuary & steeple: 2 options—asphalt or steel shingles. Asphalt bid is \$58,000 to \$ 78,00 with one bid yet to come. Steel shingles will last longer but cost more. Steel shingles range from \$ 93,000 to \$ 116,000 with one bid to come in . Labor included.

Council recommends steel on the steeple due to accessibility and longer life. Council isn't formally recommending, but opinions lean toward longer of life steel and the steepness of sanctuary roof being a factor for labor cost.

Sanctuary has ice damming due to poor insulation in roof. A 3 inch Styrofoam option to insulate roof would prevent ice damming and make heating more efficient A bid of \$ 25,000 with one more to come in.

An insurance claim was put in last year for hail damage to these roofs and we received a payment of \$ 61,000 to be used towards this repair.

Unbelievable !!!! 150 years !!!! Trinity Lutheran Church, Welcome, MN, will be celebrating its 150th Anniversary on Pentecost Sunday. May 19th!! Worship will be held at 10:30 AM with a light lunch to follow.

Please join us for a celebration !!!

It is with great joy, we look back at a 150 years of worship and fellowship. On Pentecost Sunday in 1874 the Rev Reck installed the first officers of the newly established congregation: The Evangelical Lutheran Congregation of Fox Lake, Manyaska, Fraser and Rolling Green. The first services were held in the homes of the members. In 1876 the congregation built a parsonage about a half mile northwest of Welcome on donated property. This parsonage also served as a place of worship. Several pieces of land were purchased in the village of Welcome in 1884. One piece was set aside for a cemetery and the other two for a church and parsonage. The first church was built in 1885 (five years before Welcome was incorporated) and served until 1937. A new church was built in 1937 by Henry Rose. The stain glass windows were dedicated in 1949, and a new parsonage was built in 1951.

In 1960, the church was remodeled and an education unit was added. At this time an all electric heating system was installed making Trinity the first church in Minnesota with all electric heat. In 1991 a new addition to the entry was added to include an elevator. In 1997 a new heating system replaced the previous electric system.

In 2001, Trinity joined with St. Peter's of Ceylon as a joint congregation; keeping each congregations' identity while sharing a pastor. In 2014, Waverly joined the joint congregation renaming the joint venture Circle of Faith. In 2021, First Lutheran of Trimont joined Circle of Faith.

The Trinity Lutheran Church building and Circle of Faith is still serving the congregation today.

Ascension Day

Thursday, May 9 11:00 am Cedar Hanson County Park, Trimont

An ascension day picnic for those who wish to celebrate. There will be a brief order of service on Ascension.

People are encouraged to bring their lunch.

Forty days after each Easter, many Christians around the world celebrate the Ascension. It's the day when the resurrected Jesus was raised up from the earth into heaven. The Ascension is the prelude to Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit came upon a gathering of people, including the apostles, in Jerusalem.

The Ascension is more important than many Christians realize. In his human body, Christ could be in only one place at a time. The risen Christ, however, can be spiritually present in any place at any time.
