

Augustus Montague Toplady! Who would ever guess that someone with a name like that would write one of the most popular hymns of all the ages, "Rock of Ages"? His father died when he was quite young, his mother spoiled him, he was considered sick and neurotic and his relatives 'couldn't stand him'. But Augustus didn't care because he was interested in the Lord. He kept a daily journal and at the age of 11 he wrote: "I praise God that I can remember no dreadful crime – to God be the glory." At 12 he was preaching sermons to anyone who would listen. At 14 he started writing hymns. He was converted to Christ at age 16 and at 22 he was ordained an Anglican priest. While at Dublin University he was opposed to

some of the Wesleyan theology and he spoke out against it in sermons as well as in hymns. He wrote "Rock of Ages" to be included in an article he wrote for a magazine where he stated that 'just as England could never, through their own efforts, repay their national debt, we could never through our own efforts ever repay our debt to God.' (Sounds familiar, doesn't it? This was about England in the 18th century – how about us in the 21st century!) Toplady died of overwork and tuberculosis at the age of 38. His final words were "My prayers are now converted into praise." Although Toplady and Wesley disagreed philosophically about many things, their hymns appear side by side in countless hymnals.

Thomas Hastings (born in Connecticut in 1784) wrote the music for "Rock of Ages" in 1830 – he was a noted hymn writer (over 1000 tunes) – in 1858 he became Director of Music at University of New York City. He felt that hymns deserved noble and reverent music. He was very instrumental in shaping the development of church music. He was hampered by bad eye problems because he was an albino, however in his lifetime he wrote over 50 volumes of church music.
