COVENANT

STUDENT'S ROLE

- Show respect for your guide, other students, adults, and property
- Refrain from talking during large group presentation
- Bring your Bible
- ♦ Make your best effort, participate in activities, and decide to have a good attitude
- Inappropriate language or taking the name of God in vain will not be tolerated
- Use or possession of alcohol, tobacco, or any illegal substance will result in immediate contact of law enforcement and parents
- All students must sit with their guide groups for the large group presentation and move with their group to and from small group time
- Roughhousing is not acceptable
- Confidentiality is of utmost importance what's said in your group stays in your group
- I-Pods, electronic games or any other electronic devices are not allowed at confirmation. There will be no warning given, and they will be taken until contact with your parents.
- Cell phones must <u>NOT</u> be used during confirmation. If you are caught with your cell phone on, it will be taken until your parents are contacted. There will be no warning given this <u>IS</u> your warning!
- Attending worship and completing sermon notes are a requirement. Unfinished sermon notes carry over from year to year. All sermon notes must be completed in order to be confirmed at the end of your second year.

Steps of enforcement by leaders and church staff

- ♦ Verbal Warning
- ♦ Call to parent
- ♦ Parent/guide/pastor conference
- Parent attend confirmation with child
- Completion of program at home under parent's supervision

PARENT'S ROLE

- ♦ Know your student's schedule
- Make confirmation attendance a priority and not optional
- Be prompt in dropping them off and picking them up
- ♦ Attend worship regularly with your student and see that they complete the required sermon notes
- Make sure that a pastor is contacted if they will be absent
- Make sure your student brings their Bible to confirmation each night
- Please be of support to the pastors and mentors they are making a big commitment to your student
