

Circle of Faith Parish Council Minutes

April 12, 2016

Meeting was called to order by President Karen Helvig.
Other members present were Marilyn Cheever, Jon Saxen,
Deanne Gaalswyk, Scott Morrow and Deb Philipp. Congregational Presidents, Henry Borchardt from Trinity, Sue
Krueger from Waverly, Jody Franck from St. Peter.
Jon Saxen made a motion to approve the agenda, Marilyn
Cheever second.

Devotions led by Pastor Anthony from Romans 12. He shared how we are one body, one family and many members. We all have roles in our nuclear family and this as same as our church family. We all have different functions and ways we can serve.

Secretary's report. Jon Saxen approved the secretary's report and Jody Franck, second.

Treasurer's report: Jody Franck made a motion to approve Treasurer's report, Marilyn Cheever second.

Pastor's report: Two Sundays of Vacation for Pastor Anthony will be June 26th and July 24th.

Parish picnic will be held at Waverly this summer. COF has paid \$110 a year for a Windows program that offered updates and free text support. This software is not necessary. We will drop this program as we don't use this database.

This Thursday, the April 14th we will live stream an Evangelizing event at Trinity beginning at 6:15 p.m.

There was a discussion on how Pastors can delegate some duties like visiting grieving families. Marilyn Cheever mentioned sending a card to families that have lost loved ones or sending cards at anniversaries and after baptisms so families know we are thinking about them. Marilyn volunteered to be in charge of this task.

Committees: There was a discussion on what committees we have and who is part of them and what are their duties. Communication committees: This is made up of volunteers from each Congregation. They look at the Ripples newsletter, researched on Honey well alert system, the COF website, within and in community and parades responsibility. Kendra Helvig and Deb Philipp are on this committee. Administrative committee: Keeping up on the Parish agreement, and it is reviewed annually. Deanne Gaalswyk and Scott Morrow have decided to join this committee. Finance committee: This consists of one member from each congregation, generally presidents are involved. Executive committee: Depends on as needed.

Old Business:

Jon Saxen made a motion to approve raising the Circle of

Faith insurance for personal property (equipment the Pastor/staff uses) and for sexual misconduct coverage by \$65. This will raise insurance coverage to &7500 for personal property and to \$50,000 to 100,000 coverage for sexual misconduct for \$65 more for the entire parish. Scott Morrow second. This coverage will begin on January 1, 2017. Audit of Treasurer book: Jody Franck and Jeff Lueth met with Treasurer Jon Saxen to look over bank statements and check registers and everything matched up! Wedding and funeral policy update: Motion by Marilyn Cheever to accept both of these policies as written. Jody Franck second.

New Business:

Honeywell: By midsummer we need to decide if we should continue using this alert system, as that is when renewal is up. The cost is \$750 a year or \$5 per household to have this means of communication.

Worship times: Discussion of having earlier Worship times at Trinity. Jody Franck suggested trying new worship times in the summer months. She suggested having 2 churches have 8:30 worship times and 1 church have 6:30 pm Wednesday night services. Beginning the first Sunday in June the worship times would stay the same for the month and then switch the other two months so each church would have one Wednesday night service for a month and then have 8:30 start times the other 2 months. Jon Saxen made a motion to accept the change of congregation times as approval of the individual councils. Jody Franck second. Additions to agenda: Pastor Larry Strenge will visit Circle of Faith Pastors and leaders next Tuesday April the 19th at Trinity. Leaders from Waverly will meet from 5:05 to 5:45 p.m. Trinity leaders will meet 6:05 to 6:45 and St. Peter leaders will meet at 6:45-7:15. Supper will be provided for Pastor Larry, Pastors and Congregational leaders. Photo directories: A question was asked about if pictures weren't taken with Lifetouch, but a picture was submitted people can still receive a photo directory. Pastor Anthony said yes families will be still able to receive a photo directory.

Jody Franck mentioned that there will be a benefit supper from 4-7 on Saturday, April 23rd at the Martin Luther High School for the St James Lutheran Church from Northrop. Jody Franck made the motion to adjourn and Jon Saxen second. Our next meeting is May 10 @ 6 pm.

The Secretary, Treasurer, and Financial Secretary reports were gone over. Lonnie made a motion to approve the reports. Bob seconded, motion carried.

Velma mentioned that she had heard concerns about kids not taking the food home from the Backpack program. Pastor Anthony will check into it.

Faith Formation report—John F. said there are three more Wednesdays of WOW left. The last day will be April 27th for this season. The end of year party will be that night. They had an average of 5 or 6 kids in attendance per night.

Caring Committee — New usher and communion lists were sent out. Thank you to all who help.

Trustees Committee report — John B. reported on the windows. The person will be working in Ceylon area next week so he will stop up and take a look at what is needed.

The Turkey Dinner will be April 24. Council members were reminded to bring their turkeys. Please remember to plan to help that day.

New Business:

Loaning chairs and tables out was discussed. Only the older chairs and tables should be loaned out. We will do a sign out sheet so people can put down how many they take, date and when they bring them back.

Parish meeting—discussion was held on implementing a new schedule for the summer months of June, July and August. Two church services will be at 8:30 am and one church would have a service on Wednesday night at 6:30 pm. Trinity would have church service at 8:30 am in June and July and we would have church with communion on Wednesday nights at 6:30 pm during August with no Sunday service at Trinity in August. The consensus was to give the new schedule a try. It was also stated that if 8:30 is a more popular time at Trinity we could do it year round if we want to. The Honeywell alert system will be used to let people know the schedule.

The Synod is asking for a meeting of 3 to 5 leaders per church to meet with them on Tuesday, April 19 at Trinity. They will beet with the pastors first and then members from Waverly at 5:06, Trinity at 5:45 and St. Peter at 6:30 pm. They are coming to see how things are going with the churches. Members from Trinity that will be meeting with them will be Henry Borchardt, John Borchardt, Lonnie and Bob Moffitt.

Pastor Anthony asked if anyone had heard any feedback on the Honeywell System. Wanted to know if everyone was getting their alerts.

Insurance update: The property coverage on Parish property was increased to \$7,500. at an extra cost of \$60. They are also looking at increasing the limit on the sexual conduct portion of the insurance for the parish. In 2017, all the custodians and organists will be receiving a W-2 form. Some are getting a 1099 now.

This Thursday, April 14, there will be a Synod Evangelism Event at Gustavus Adolphus in St. Peter from 6:30—8:30/9. They will be live streaming this at Trinity. The event will be on tools on how to reach out to others. A reminder will be put on the Honeywell Alert System.

Pastor Anthony will be taking vacation on two Sundays this summer, June 26 and July 24.

Confirmation is May 1st at Trinity—a motion was made by Bob, seconded by Jean to recommend the four students for confirmation and to become voting members. The four are: Sami Meyer, Caelyn Harder. Derek Hughes Todd Morrow/ motion carried.

The next council mtg. will be June 14, 2016 at 7:30 pm. The meeting was adjourned and closed with the Lord's Prayer.








John Keble (1792–1866) was known as an outstanding and highly respected preacher and Bible scholar. He was inspired to write one of his poems by Luke 24:29, where the two disciples were met by Jesus on the road to Emmaus. The disciples had begged Jesus to stay with them, telling Him that if the "Sun of my soul" would stay with them, it would never get dark. Keble used that phrase to write the poem which he included in his book of poems for use throughout the church year. The book was so successful it went through 109 editions! The proceeds from the book helped support his small village church in Hursley near Oxford in England. He was a professor of poetry at Oxford for 10 years prior to the many years he served as parish pastor at Hursley. The music for "Sun of my Soul" was given the name of 'Hursley' to honor that parish in the town of about 1500. He wrote 765 hymns and in 1869 Keble College was founded at Oxford University. Alfred, Lord Tennyson was once asked, "What does Jesus mean to you?" He pointed to a flower and said, "What the sun is to this flower is what Jesus means to me – the Sun of my soul."
